The administration announced an end to Temporary Protected Status for El Salvador. **This will affect 200,000 Salvadoran immigrants** who have lived in, worked in and raised children in the United States for nearly 20 years.

In the DC area alone almost 30,000 of our neighbors are Salvadoran immigrants holding TPS and thousands more are their children, spouses and friends.

This decision will have a devastating impact on our community.

Ayuda stands in support of our Salvadoran immigrant neighbors by providing legal consultations and direct representation to those who stand to lose their status.

We are actively working to expand these services to support the growing needs of our immigrant community.
