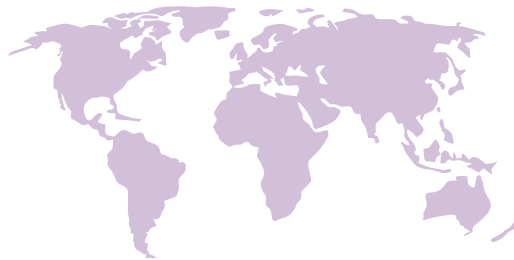

In 2023, our clinics drew individuals from 34 countries, including:

Afghanistan, Bolivia, Cameroon, China, Colombia, Congo, the Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Ethiopia, Ghana, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Uganda, Pakistan, Peru, the Philippines, and Venezuela.
