**Get a one-on-one telephone

your immigration questions.**

**Call 202-787-5311 on November 8 between
10am and 2pm.** We will do our best to give you an appointment to speak with an attorney. **Appointments will be scheduled for November 15.** An attorney will call you during your appointment time. The services you receive will be limited by time, expertise, and the information you provide. During the call, you will receive advice that is specific to your situation, but the attorney you speak with will not represent you after the consultation.

Please have these things ready during your consult:

1. All Immigration Documents
2. Your passport and the passports of your family members.
3. Police reports, if you have been the victim of a crime or if you have been accused of committing a crime
4. Criminal court documents, if you have been accused or convicted of a crime, even if charges were dismissed
