Step 3

Be ready to receive a phone call during your scheduled time.

Consults will be scheduled for April 25.

What to bring to your consultation?

- All Immigration Documents
- Your passport and the passports of your family members.
- Police reports, if you have been the victim of a crime or if you have been accused of committing a crime.
- Criminal court documents, if you have been accused or convicted of a crime, even if charges were dismissed.
